

DRUG TESTING

1. Cooperate with the probation officer and answer all questions honestly.
2. As a condition of the Court's order, you are subject to random urine testing for alcohol and drug usage at such times as you are ordered to submit to these by a probation officer.
3. You are advised that failure or refusal to submit to such testing or tampering with a urine specimen will be considered a violation of the Court order. Failure to provide a urine specimen within two hours of the request will be considered a violation of the Court order.
4. Any positive result is a violation of the Court's order. It will be reported to the Court and may result in further sanctions.
5. You are required to inform your probation officer prior to the test about any prescribed medication you are taking. You may be required to provide verification from your physician.
6. You may challenge a positive test result at the time you are tested and request a confirmation test. If the confirmation test is positive, this test will be at your own expense.
7. Test results will be released to you, your parents or guardian, and to the Court. Release to any other parties will be available only by Court order.
